7th Grade Immunizations

Before entering the 7th grade, state law requires that all students must be up to date on immunizations or have a current waiver on file. The required immunizations a child must have by 7th grade are: DTAP, Polio, MMR, Hep B, Varicella, and Meningococcal. If your child's immunizations are current, you are all set to start the next school year. If your child will have any immunizations that are not up to date before school starts, please provide the school office with a copy of the updated immunization record or a current waiver by August 17, 2022. Waivers are no longer available through the school and can be acquired through the Ingham County Health Department. Students who are not compliant with the State of Michigan will be excluded from school until updated immunizations or a waiver are provided. Records can be turned into the office or sent to wheelemk@haslett.k12.mi.us.
