District Construction Update Fall 2020

We are excited to share that Phase III of our 2018 Bond Proposal, which began back on June 1, 2020, is near final completion. With the exception of a few minor items that still need to be addressed, we are ready to open our doors to students when we return to face-to-face instruction. Over the summer, due to COVID-19, we experienced many construction challenges, including manpower availability and material shortages. Phase IV of the 2018 Bond Proposal, involving new construction and upgrades to our High School gymnasium, will continue until the end of December 2020.

Our construction team worked extremely hard to ensure our buildings would be ready for the original start of the school year. Due to COVID-19, we made a recommendation to the Haslett Board of Education the beginning of August to begin the 2020-21 school year fully online. The decision to go virtual was not related to our construction project. Near the end of the summer, material delivery delays occurred and caused an unforeseen change in our construction timeline. However, we were granted temporary occupancy for our buildings at the end of August, and staff were able to work in the buildings and teachers provided instruction from their classrooms. Additional flooring, restroom upgrades, painting, and punch list items were completed during the month of September.

Our building and classroom upgrades would not have been possible without the support of our community. These upgrades will greatly improve our ability to continue to deliver quality instruction to our students. We appreciate your patience during this unprecedented time.
