### Snow Days

Winter has arrived in Michigan with the onset of colder temperatures and snow in the air. Next week Monday, **February 1**, students in grades K-5 will return to school for "in-person" instruction. Students in grades 6-12 will return to school on Monday, **February 8**.

With that in mind, if severe weather conditions occur, we will consider a school closure to ensure the safety of our students and staff. Beginning February 1, 2021, if there is a school closure, **ALL** student cohorts (Viking, Blue, and Gold) will be affected.

Once the decision to close school is made (usually the morning of the closure), **ALL** school families will immediately receive phone and email notifications based on contact information available in our Skyward student information system. *(Parents and guardians may add additional phone numbers and email addresses by logging into their Family Access account.)*

- Closure information will be posted on the district website as soon as a decision to close school has been finalized.
- The District Mobile App will push out notifications to its subscribers.
- Local media stations are contacted as soon as the District makes a decision to close school.

### School Schedules

As a reminder, Murphy, Ralya, and Wilkshire students will return to school on Monday, **February 1**. Bus transportation is available for students who live within the District boundaries. The elementary BLUE cohort will attend school in the morning, the elementary Gold cohort will attend school in the afternoon, and the Viking cohort will remain online ONLY.

On **February 8**, students who attend Haslett Middle School and Haslett High School will return to in-person instruction. Please reference the [Hybrid Schedule](#) on the District website for specific days and times. This Hybrid implementation will be a transitional move back to a more normal school experience.

- Blue, Gold, and Viking cohorts will attend 6 (six) 45-minute classes, both virtually and in-person, with a 5-minute break between classes. **(Note: This is a change from the current BLOCK schedule.)**
- Students in the BLUE cohort will attend Hours 4, 5, and 6 at school (in person) on Monday afternoons and Hours 1, 2, and 3 at school (in person) on Tuesday mornings.
- Students in the GOLD cohort will attend hours 4, 5, and 6 at school (in person) on Thursday afternoons and Hours 1, 2, and 3 at school (in person) on Friday mornings.
- All Viking cohort classes will be available virtually.

Please watch for **additional information** from our secondary principals regarding pertinent information you may need as the District moves closer to implementation of the Hybrid Plan at Haslett Middle School and Haslett High School on Monday, **February 8**.

Your support and patience continue to be critical to our success as we move forward with our plans to return to school.
