Parent/Guardian Survey Questions and Answers

In early February, Haslett Public Schools implemented a Hybrid Learning Plan. Students were offered the opportunity to remain learning online ONLY or opt into a Hybrid learning mode which included face-to-face and online instruction.

At the time of this publication, the District is discussing adding more face-to-face instruction for students who are participating in the Hybrid learning mode. A survey was distributed to parents on February 19 to determine whether families would be interested in switching the learning mode for their children, if more face-to-face time were added.

The district is in the process of discussing options to increase the amount of face-to-face instruction for students in the Hybrid cohort. Because many of our parents/guardians have had questions, we have extended the deadline for completing the survey to 4:00 p.m. on Monday, March 1, 2021. The questions below are ones that have been brought to our attention. Please do not hesitate to contact Mr. Cook, Superintendent of Schools, or your child's building principal.

Student Schedules

If a parent/guardian requests a change in their child's learning mode, will that request be honored?

A request to change the learning mode of a student can ONLY be honored if the district can accommodate class size requirements.

Will the full-time online option continue to be available for students?

Over 45% of our students are presently utilizing the online ONLY learning mode. Haslett Schools intends to offer this mode to students through the end of the 2020-21 school year.

Safety Procedures and Mitigation Protocols

What procedures and protocols will the District be following to ensure the safety of students and staff?

The District will continue to follow the State and local guidelines for universal masking, handwashing/hand sanitizing, frequent cleaning of student learning spaces, and physical distancing.

When will the staff be fully vaccinated?

All Haslett Public School employees who chose to receive the Pfizer vaccine should be fully vaccinated (+14 days) by March 19, 2021 (no quarantine required 14 days after the second inoculation).

Transmission/Testing

How will parents be notified if COVID-19 cases occur and it is necessary to quarantine teachers or students?

The majority of Haslett teachers have been vaccinated, and they will not need to quarantine. Regarding notification, the school district will send a general notification to parents and staff as soon as the Ingham County Health Department has verified the COVID-19 case, protecting confidentiality of the infected student or staff member.
