Equity Plan Survey

Submission Date: March 19, 2021

During the 2020-21 school year, Haslett administrators and professional teaching staff have been collaborating with **Dr. Terry Flennaugh**, Associate Professor of Urban Education Initiatives at Michigan State University. Dr. Flennaugh has been working with staff to understand the meaning of anti-bias behavior, social justice, and equity.

Dr. Flennaugh has also facilitated building professional development, met with the Board of Education, and shared his expertise to prepare the district to develop a customized Equity Plan. This plan would promote the practice of fair and just relationships within Haslett Public Schools and would help the district to build a community free of bias and favoritism.

The next step for Haslett Public Schools is to gather input from our community through a **survey**. The goal of the foundation of a **District Equity Plan** is that the entire community should have an opportunity to share their opinions and ideas.

Dr. Flennaugh and his staff will email a survey to parents, guardians, teachers, school staff, school board members, and high school students on Friday, **March 5, 2021**.

This survey will solicit feedback on what our Haslett school community members identify as the strengths, priorities, and values of the district as they relate to equity. It will also ask for contact information and a statement of interest from parties who wish to participate on a **Haslett Equity Planning Committee**.

The Haslett Equity Planning Committee, along with Dr. Flennaugh, will develop and roll out an Equity Plan to build a community where respect and fairness are at the core of the organization. This Planning Committee will discuss an equity framework within the Haslett context, will focus on understanding the feedback from the survey, and will finalize components of the Equity Plan. This plan will be implemented during the 2021-22 school year.

Thanks to all of you for supporting our District Goals. Thanks also to the **Haslett's Voice for Change** members who collaborated with district staff and shared their ideas and stories.

Please look for the Equity Survey in a separate email. Identifying the strengths, priorities, and values of our district from different perspectives is invaluable information.
