Increased In-Person Instruction Begins March 22, 2021

Last night, the Haslett Board of Education approved the Revised Responsive Return to School Plan. Beginning March 22, 2021, Haslett Public Schools will increase in-person learning time for students in grades Kindergarten through Grade 12. Parents, guardians, and students will receive additional details and notification of cohort changes from the Principal of their child's school early this week. Refer to the chart below for a school calendar.

The Haslett High School schedule will change after Spring Break (April 12 – April 16). This change is due to the administration of the SAT and PSAT, as well as the M-STEP for students in Grade 11. A specific assessment schedule will be sent home from the Haslett High School office.

Elementary Schools (Murphy Elementary, Ralya Elementary, and Wilkshire ECC)

Beginning March 22, the BLUE and GOLD cohorts will be combined for elementary students, and these students will attend school for a full day. Students will eat lunch at school and also attend Creative Arts in-person.

Secondary Schools (Haslett High School and Haslett Middle School)

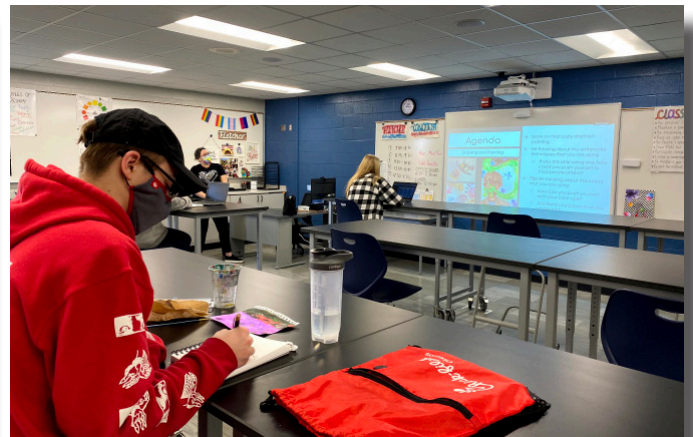
