

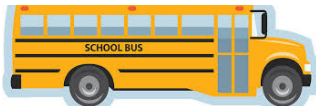

New Student School Schedule

March 22, 2021

On Tuesday, March 9, Governor Whitmer signed House Bill 4049 requiring schools to offer at least 20 hours of in-person instruction to students, beginning no later than March 22, 2021. Failing to meet this provision will result in Haslett Public Schools losing \$500,000 in additional COVID-19 funding. Consequently, the Board of Education approved a new "Return to School Plan" for students in grades K-12, beginning March 22, 2021. This plan increases student in-person time to 20 hours per week. The Haslett Education Association collaborated with the District Administrators to develop this plan.

This week, our building principals sent home specific information and student schedules. All students will be attending school Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday, five (5) hours each day. Wednesday will continue to be an asynchronous day. **The week of March 29, there will be a slight change in the weekly schedule. All students will attend school Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday (in-person or online). Thursday (April 1) will be an asynchronous day, and there will be no school on Friday (April 2).**

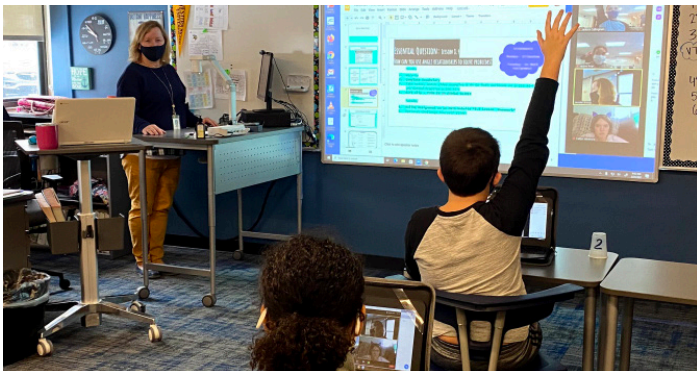
Elementary Schools (Wilkshire ECC, Ralya and Murphy Elementary Schools):

- Students will attend school for a full day.
- VIKING cohort teachers will remain the same.
- BLUE and GOLD cohorts will be combined, and students will attend school in-person together.
- Students will be served lunch at school with an opportunity to go outside for recess. (Lunch/Recess will be 45 minutes at WECC and 40 minutes at Murphy/Ralya)
- In-person Creative Arts (Art, Music, Physical Education, and STEAM) will be offered.

Haslett High School and Haslett Middle School:

- Students will attend for a partial day.
- All teachers will be implementing concurrent instruction.
- BLUE and GOLD cohorts will be combined, and students will attend school in-person together.
- Viking Time (MS) and Advisory Time (HS) will be part of the daily schedule.
- Haslett High School schedule will change the week after Spring Break (April 12–16) to accommodate SAT and PSAT administration. Haslett High School will send the testing schedule home to parents/guardians.
- Monday, **April 12** and Friday, **April 16** will be in-person or "synchronous" days (online). Tuesday, **April 13**, Wednesday, **April 14**, and Thursday, **April 15** will be "asynchronous" days for ALL Haslett High School Students.

Transportation will be provided, and transportation schedules have been revised to accommodate new student schedules at ALL buildings. Curbside lunch will continue to be provided to families who need support.
