COVID-19 Vaccination Survey (Children ages 5-11)

On October 26, 2021, the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) will consider Pfizer's emergency application for approval of their COVID-19 vaccine to be used for children ages 5-11. In anticipation of the FDA's approval, the Ingham County Health Department (ICHD) is requesting local school districts survey parents to determine the number of families interested in having their children receive Pfizer's COVID-19 vaccine. This data will assist the ICHD in determining how many vaccines are needed for our county. **Please click on the link to the right to complete the survey.** Following the FDA's approval of Pfizer's application, Haslett Public Schools will be working closely with the ICHD to offer vaccine clinics in our area. **The survey will close on October 29, 2021.**
